<b>Sparkling Wines</b>		
Mora Vintage Brut 2017	135.0	
<i>Green Apple / Cheesecake / Lemon</i> – Aged for 80 months on lees. A Pinot Noir dominant blend (78%) with Chardonnay (22%). On the palate the zingy lemon and apple notes, particularly the bright Granny Smith dance alongside rich elements of baked cheesecake, adding a delightful creaminess. Prolonged lees contact adds brioche and toast.

<i>Citrus / Brioche / Finesse</i> – A Chardonnay dominant blend with Pinot Noir, from four of our estate vineyard sites in Pisa and Bannockburn. Lovely, lifted notes of white blossom, lemon curd, Royal Gala apples and white-fleshed stone fruit. The perfect aperitif.		
Mora Rosé Brut NV	95.0	19.5
<i>Layered / Apricot / Alluring</i> – Beautiful Rosé sparkling sourced from four of our estate vineyard sites in Pisa and Bannockburn. Lifted red berry perfume of raspberries and rose petals, creamy palate and fine persistent bead. A food-matching sparkling wine with nuance and intrigue.		
<b>White Wines</b>		
Mora ALBI White 2025 (Bannockburn) <i>Limited Release</i>	115.0	23.5
<i>Almond Croissant / Rhubarb / Wild Strawberry</i> – Our third vintage of Albi, this unique white wine is made entirely from Pinot Noir. Born from our love of the variety and our desire to explore its versatility, Albi celebrates Pinot Noir as the only grape capable of producing premium rosé, white and red wines. Though it presents as a white wine, Albi carries red wine characteristics – depth, texture and concentration – while maintaining freshness and elegance. Albi means ‘white’ in Latin.		
Mora Old Vine Sauvignon Blanc 2024 (Pisa)	90.0	19.0
<i>Elderflower / Fresh Pear / Elegant</i> – sourced from 29-year-old vines in our Eden Vineyard in Pisa bringing brilliant fruit concentration. Due to extended time on lees in barrel and in tank, this wine has beautiful weight and complexity.		
Mora Eden Pisa Sauvignon Blanc 2024 (Organic)	90.0	19.0
<i>Textural / Guava / Elegant</i> – Distinctive aromas of guava, green pea, and blackcurrant leap from the glass, showcasing the hallmark varietal character of the region. The palate is layered and refined, with a mineral backbone and elegant texture. Six months in neutral French oak has added subtle complexity and depth, enhancing the wine’s natural freshness and drive.		
Mora Pinot Gris 2024 (Bannockburn)	85.0	19.0
<i>Creamy / Pear / Textural</i> – Aromas of ripe pear, crisp apple and white florals lead into a palate that is both vibrant and textural. A fine thread of zesty acidity provides freshness, while a delicate hint of hazelnut and spice adds depth.		
RUA Pinot Gris 2024	65.0	15.5
<i>Bright / Crisp / Fresh</i> – Enticing aromas of pear, white peach and fresh linens on the nose. Lychee, blackcurrant and hints of nutmeg on the palate with a salty acidity and fine texture.		
Mora Riesling 2023 (Bannockburn)	78.5	17.5
<i>Bright / Mandarin / Silken</i> – These 22-year-old vines have dug deep through the alluvial soils and schist rock and bring a fleshy fruit character to the wine. The lively crisp red apple acidity is beautifully balanced with the sweetness. Blossom and citrus dominate. <i>Residual Sugar: 50 g/L</i>		
Mora Dry Riesling 2023 (Bannockburn)	85.0	19.0
<i>Vibrant / Elderflower / Balanced</i> – Our Mora 2023 Dry Riesling is selected from a single block called Maia in our Felton Terraces vineyard, where vines planted in 2001 continue to produce fruit of exceptional character. A cool spring led to a slow start, but a hot, dry summer ensured even ripeness across the bunches. The result is a beautifully expressive Riesling with fine florals, mineral purity and bright acidity balanced by a delicate hint of residual sugar. <i>Residual Sugar: 2.2 g/L</i>

<p>Mora Chardonnay 2023</p> <p><i>Citrus / Stonefruit / Honeysuckle</i> – A blend from our vineyards in both Pisa and Bannockburn. Aged in 20% new oak for 9 months. A creamy texture behind citrus and stone fruit, baked cheesecake and panna cotta. A beautiful balance with floral hints to finish.</p>	95.0	21.0
<p>Mora Eden Pisa Chardonnay 2023 (Organic)</p> <p><i>Layered / Apricot / Alluring</i> – This wine opens with alluring aromas of golden peach and nectarine, layered with roast hazelnut, flint, and a whisper of smoky complexity. The palate is rich and creamy, evoking crème brûlée, balanced by vibrant Meyer lemon freshness.</p>	125.0	27.0
<p>Mora Eden Pisa Chardonnay 2022 (Organic)</p> <p><i>Layered / Apricot / Alluring</i> – Eden is our haven in Pisa, where evolution and harmony exists. Once an orchard of lush stone fruit and apples, it is now a flourishing organic vineyard. This chardonnay from Eden is sumptuous and complex. <p>Mora Pinot Rosé 2024 (Bannockburn)</p> <p><i>Perfumed / Summer Berries / Delicate</i> – This alpine-fresh, dry rosé showcases purity and finesse. Aromas of wild strawberries and blackcurrant leaf are lifted by a delicate hint of fresh tarragon, adding a subtle herbal complexity. The palate is crisp and finely textured, with vibrant red berries and a touch of citrus zest. A long, mouthwatering finish leaves a refreshing impression, with the herbal twist adding depth and character.</p>	90.0	19.0
<p>RUA Rosé 2025</p> <p><i>Bright / Floral / Exotic</i> – A blend across two sub regions, Bannockburn and Pisa. This vintage opens with an enticing bouquet of wild strawberries and delicate lychee, lifted by a subtle hint of pink peppercorn and fresh snow pea.</p>	65.0	15.5

<p>Mora Pinot Noir 2022 (Bannockburn)</p> <p><i>Red Cherry / Summer Berries / Baking Spice</i> – Alluring blue and violet fruit, delicious ripe plums, fragrant with a lovely purity. The palate offers good density, silky tannins, subtle oak and nice length. A classic example of Central Otago Pinot Noir.</p>	105.0	22.0
<p>RUA Pinot Noir 2023</p> <p><i>Vibrant / Raspberry / Wild Thyme</i> – Fresh and vibrant with concentrated raspberry, red plum and wild thyme aromas. The palate showcases soft silky tannins. A Beautiful vintage of RUA followers will love.</p>	65.0	15.5
<p>Mora Laeto Pinot Noir 2024 (Bannockburn) <i>Limited Release</i></p> <p><i>Floral / Blackberries / Chilled</i> – A playful and vibrant red wine. Bright, juicy dark cherries and brambled berries, Enjoy chilled on a warm sunny day. Laeto means ‘lush’ in Latin.</p>	67.5	14.5
<p>Mora Vale Pisa Pinot Noir 2024 (Organic)</p> <p><i>Earthy / Plum / Silky</i> – From our Vale Vineyard in Pisa. A vibrant expression of Pisa fruit, this Pinot Noir opens with alluring aromas of black plum and strawberries. The palate is plush and layered, showcasing a silky, velvet texture balanced by fine tannins.</p>	185.0	39.5
<p>Mora Kolo Pinot Noir 2022 (Bannockburn)</p> <p><i>Dark Fruits / Savoury / Structured</i> – Local legend tells of a warrior named Kolo who protected his family from the Pouakai – Haast Eagle, and is the namesake of our most premium offering. Dark and brooding, with lifted florals of lavender and hints of fennel and licorice. Wild bramble berries and tamarillo lend vibrant fruit character, while well-integrated tannins provide structure and finesse.</p>	235.0	
<p>Mora Kolo Pinot Noir 2019 (Bannockburn)</p> <p><i>Dark Fruits / Spices / Structured</i> – Prominent notes of Black Doris plum and wild bramble berries with hints of nasturtium. This wine features silky, well- integrated tannins, contributing to its concentration and intensity. Bottle age introduces savoury and leather flavours, which have integrated beautifully with the dark fruit flavours synonymous with the Kolo.</p>	255.0
