### Mora Vintage Brut 2016

*Stonefruit | Roasted Nuts | Complex* - Aged for a minimum of 36 months on lees. A Pinot Noir dominant blend (65%) with Chardonnay (35%). The palate shows a fine mineral thread with citrus notes of tangerine on the nose. The structure is weighty and rich but beautifully balanced with taut, bright acidity.

### Mora Brut NV

*Citrus | Brioche | Finesse* - A Chardonnay dominant blend with Pinot Noir, sourced from four of our estate vineyard sites in Pisa and Bannockburn. Lovely, lifted notes of white blossom, lemon curd, Royal Gala apples and white-fleshed stone fruit. The perfect aperitif.

## White Wines

### Mora Sauvignon Blanc 2022 (Pisa)

*Complex | Lime Sorbet | Textural* - Our Eden Vineyard is located in the Pisa subregion of Central Otago. The own-rooted Sauvignon Blanc vines were planted in 1993, and are the oldest certified organic vines in Central Otago. The vine age gives complexity and structure whilst hints of passionfruit complement the zesty, vibrant palate.

### Mora Old Vine Sauvignon Blanc 2022 (Pisa)

*Elderflower | Fresh Pear | Elegant* - sourced from 29-year-old vines in our Eden Vineyard in Pisa. Due to extended time on lees in barrel and in tank, this wine has beautiful weight and complexity. This, combined with the small bunches and small berries typical of old vines, gives the wine great concentration of flavour.

### Mora Pinot Gris 2022 (Bannockburn)

*Creamy | Pear | Textural* - A blend of our blocks from both sides of Bannockburn - 63% Felton Terraces and 37% Cairnmuir Flats. Beautiful weight and texture on the palate. Pure and pristine with aromas of fresh pear and apple. Zesty acidity with a subtle hazelnut character.

### Rua Pinot Gris 2023

*Bright | Crisp | Fresh* - Enticing aromas of pear, white peach and fresh linens on the nose. Lychee, blackcurrant and hints of nutmeg on the palate with a salty acidity and fine texture.

### Mora Riesling 2022 (Bannockburn)

*Bright | Mandarin | Silken* - Originating from the Redback Ridge block, these 22-year-old vines have dug deep through the alluvial soils and schist rock and bring a fleshy fruit character to the wine. The lively acidity is beautifully balanced with the sweetness, making this a gorgeous lunchtime drop. Blossom, white peach and mandarin on the nose.

### Mora Dry Riesling 2022 (Bannockburn)

*Vibrant | Elderflower | Silken* - Selected from a single block called Maia on our Felton Terraces vineyard. The vines from this block are well established, having been planted in 2001. The settled and warm 2022 growing season gave us beautiful fine florals and mineral notes, and some enjoyable tension between the bright acidity and slight hint of residual sugar. Lime blossom and ginger notes.

*Citrus / Stone Fruits / Shortbread* – Sourced from the Pisa sub-region, hand-picked and whole bunch pressed. Appealing stone fruit, citrus and nectarine. A beautiful balance, neither oaky nor buttery, cool acidity and ending with hints of shortbread in a long

**Mora Eden Pisa Sauvignon Blanc 2022 (Organic)**

*Textural / Guava / Elegant* – Imbued with minerality, elegance and fruit purity. Classic Central Otago Sauvignon Blanc flavours – guava, green pea and blackcurrant leaf. The palate displays texture and complexity, a result of four months of aging in neutral French oak barrels.

**Mora Eden Pisa Chardonnay 2021 (Organic)**

*Layered / Apricot / Alluring* – Eden is our haven in Pisa – a place where evolution and harmony exists. Once an orchard full of lush stone fruit and apples, it is now a flourishing organic vineyard. This Chardonnay from Eden is sumptuous and complex. A bright palate of pink grapefruit, apricot and papaya.

*Perfumed / Summer Berries / Delicate* – A lighter, dry, more sophisticated style of rosé. Its pale colour, delicate fruit, crisp acidity and light touches of minerality speak to our premium blocks at Felton Terraces from which this wine originates.
